This week...



We have been watching our caterpillars grow bigger and stronger over the week. Some children have noticed how hairy they have become!

This week we have had lots of discussion about the technology that we use every day. The children were able to use our class cameras to take a photo of something that makes us happy. We talked about our photos and then wrote a sentence about our picture.



In maths, we began to discuss the concept of 'sharing' fairly between friends. We learnt about the words 'fair', 'share', 'equal', 'remainder'.

In phonics we have learnt about the naughty digraph 'ay' which we find in words such as 'play', 'stay', and 'way'. We also read and wrote words with the consonant clusters 'tw' and 'ft'.
