

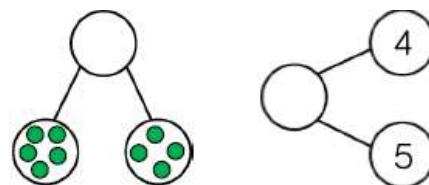
English:



We are learning about Traditional Tales at the moment. We recapped the Gingerbread Man this week as the children had been learning about that story in Reception. Now we are moving on to Little Red Riding Hood. Please note that we have told the children there are lots of different versions of traditional tales. We have chosen a version of Red Riding Hood where Grandma is not eaten and the wolf is scared away.

Maths:

Next week we are going to finish off recapping our place value to ten work, which also recaps some of the learning done in Reception. We will then be moving on to addition and subtraction and showing the children the part part whole model (pictured below) which encourages the children to 'see' addition and subtraction with objects, pictorial representations and numbers.
