

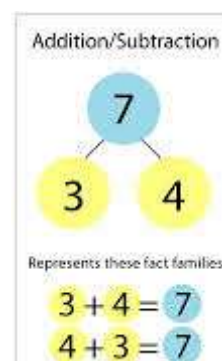
English:



We are moving on to the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears. The aim for the week will be for the children to replace the bears with their own characters (likely aliens or monsters due to our topic!) and write their own version of the story, keeping the repetition of the original.

Maths:

Next week we will be looking at further addition, mostly concentrating on 'fact families' within 10. The children will be working on finding all the pairs of number that total 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9. We will also talk about how you can switch the addends in a number sentence and still total the same e.g. $2+3=5$ and $3+2=5$.
