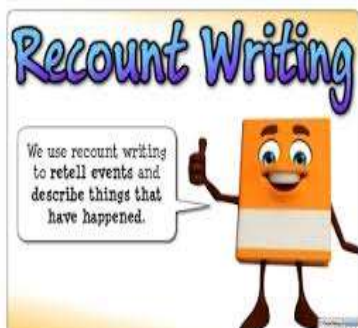


English:



Next half term we will be working on simple recounts. This will involve learning about the past tense - children will be learning how to use -ed endings for particular words.

We will be linking this to our mini topic of the UK - the children will get the chance to do a variety of activities based on the four UK countries and then will recount what they did.

Maths:

The children have loved their learning about fact families so far! We will continue to try to learn and embed the number bonds to 10 after half term, again with a big focus on switching the addends to give another number sentence e.g. $6 + 4 = 10$, so $4 + 6 = 10$



Spelling homework

Please note that after the holiday the children will be given their own spelling book with 8 spellings weekly. This will be linked to their phonics learning. Please use the rest of the page for spelling practise. Tests will be done in the back of the book.

Reading

As mentioned in last week's blog, we will have to continue working 1:1 with the children on Phonics Screening. This will be taking the place of an individual read with the class teacher. TA reads should commence as normal. Watch out for Guided Reading next half term - the children have been practising for this and are very excited!
