English In English we are leaving our fairy tale theme behind. We shall instead be focussing on instruction writing. We shall be looking at imperative (bossy) verbs. We will start by writing instructions to make a jam sandwich. We will be leading up to writing a set of instructions for making their fruit salad that they made last week.



Maths In maths we will start a three week topic looking at the using addition and subtraction. This week we are looking at the number bonds to 20. By now the children should be familiar with these, and we are focussing on using and applying this knowledge to solve problems involving these numbers.



Science Last week each Year 1 class started their class wormery. This is a special habitat filled with soil, sand and leaves that allows us to keep and study worms. The children loved finding the worms to fill the wormery, and this week we shall be writing up about the wormery, before starting to monitor the creatures.
