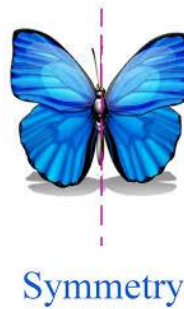
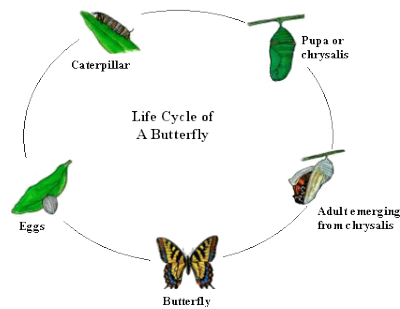

This week...

We have had a lovely sunny week the children have enjoyed exploring areas both inside and outside the classroom. The children have been fascinated by the caterpillars grow and form their Chrysalis'. We have also been thinking about the elements of a story such as setting, characters and events. The children have been thinking about what the butterfly from the Hungry Caterpillar story would do next? Where would they go? Who would they meet? What might they do?



In maths we have been practising counting in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s and counting forwards and backwards. We have also been consolidating what we have been learning about sharing between groups and used this knowledge to solve different problems. We have also been using the patterns on butterflies wings to explore the concept of symmetry.
