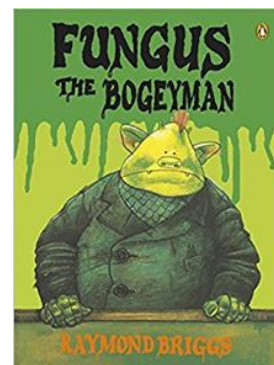


English:

Please try and keep their reading, writing and Maths going during the holidays.

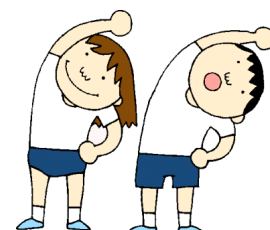
It could be reading road signs when stuck in traffic; keeping a diary, or "It has been raining for two weeks, how many days is that?"
