

English:

Fables, traditional tales and speech have been our topic this week. We looked at the story of the Frog and the Scorpion; chose adjectives to describe the animals; discussed what characteristics are; talked about whether something is 'in our nature'; and the features of a fable, before ending the week with a long write about an animal of our choice.
