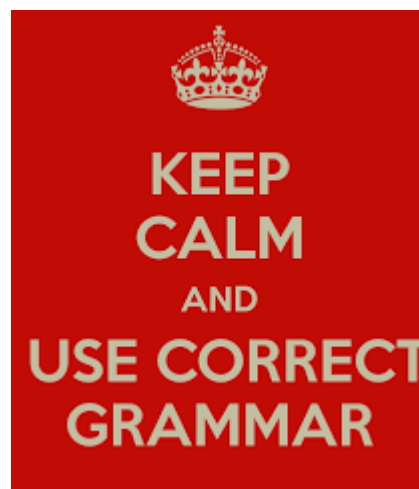


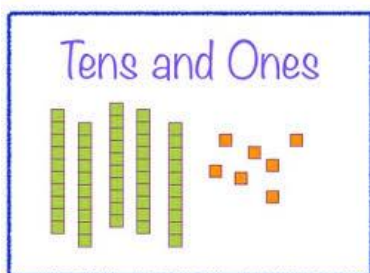
**English:**

Next week we are going to be covering some of the Year 1 grammar objectives, concentrating on the suffixes -ed and -ing. At home it would be useful to introduce the idea that we change words for the past and the present (now).

You could also try playing a game in which you do an action and say what you're doing e.g. 'Now I am walking'. Then see if your child can use -ed to change it to the past e.g. 'You walked'.



**Maths:**



In Maths we are continuing to build on our understanding of place value in numbers to 20. We have worked a lot on tens and ones (units) and have established that the 'teen' in teen numbers really represents a ten. At home it would be useful to practise counting on from 10 (we say putting a 10 in your head and count from the next number).

**Art:**

The children have designed an animal sculpture (in keeping with our latest Science topic!) that they can choose to make out of clay or modelling wire next week.
