We have had a very promising start to 2018 with our diary writing about the Christmas holidays! Next week we will be learning about the comparative suffixes -er and -est (e.g. small → smaller → smallest). A great way to introduce this idea at home is to compare the same object in different sizes - clothes from different family members are perfect for this!



Maths (a note on number bonds):

This week the children were practising their addition and subtraction skills. Children who know their number bonds to 10 and all related facts well are much better able to extend their learning with these skills.

As a short homework task this weekend in preparation for more addition/subtraction next week, please spend some time looking at number bonds and their addition/subtraction facts e.g. $1+9=10$ / $9+1=10$ / $10-1=9$ / $10-9=1$
