We have enjoyed the spring sunshine, talking about what plants and animals need to grow and why. We have enjoyed looking more closely at the details of plants!

We are enjoying the book Jasper's Beanstalk, which is teaching us about the life cycle of a bean and how we plant and look after the seeds. We have loved planting our very own beans! We will continue to observe what happens over the next few days and will see if it grows as tall as we estimated!



Staying with the growing theme, we are using our imaginations to consider different things that could grow up to the sky and what could be waiting at the top! We had fun retelling the story and even making up our own!

The children created a keeping clean teeth poster after the dentist visit who talked about her job and the importance of keeping your teeth healthy. They listened very carefully to what she said and asked her lots of questions about her job.

In maths, we have continued with subtraction, playing games and solving practical problems. We had a go at recording number sentences, for example, $4 - 1 = 3$.
