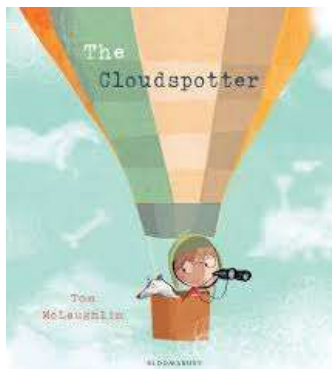
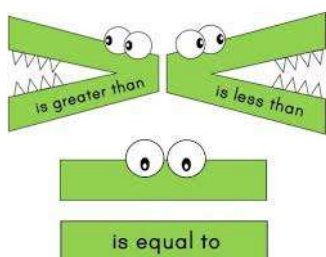


English:
