This week in Phonics...

We have learnt four new sounds d, o, sh, g and all about the cuddling ck. The letters c and k like to have a cuddle sometimes and when they do they make one ck sound! We practised reading words with this new sound in them.

In maths we have introduced 2D shapes which the children now know are 'flat shapes!'. We have been describing their features (sides, corners) and have played a variety of games to reinforce their learning. We also touched on positional language and describing where something is (E.g. behind, next to, in front, in between, under).



The special Hindu festival of Diwali began on Wednesday, the festival of light. We learnt why it is celebrated, through the story of Rama and Sita and how Hindu's prepare for this special event. We even had a chance to create our own Diya lamps using clay!

U, b, ng, oa are our new sounds and we will also be practising writing words and captions with all the new sounds we have learnt.

We will begin to talk to the children about the upcoming Christmas play and will start to learn a few of the songs!
